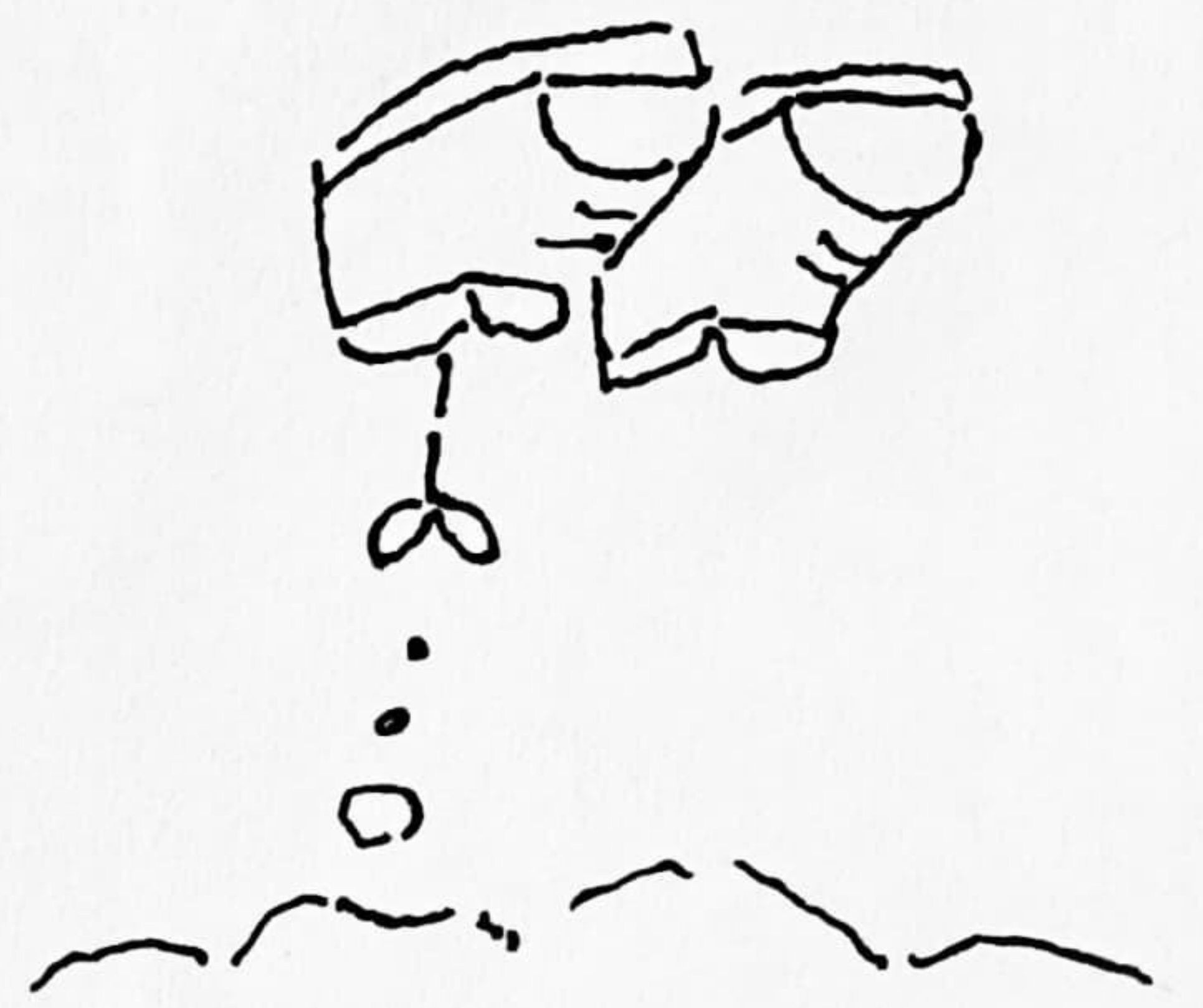
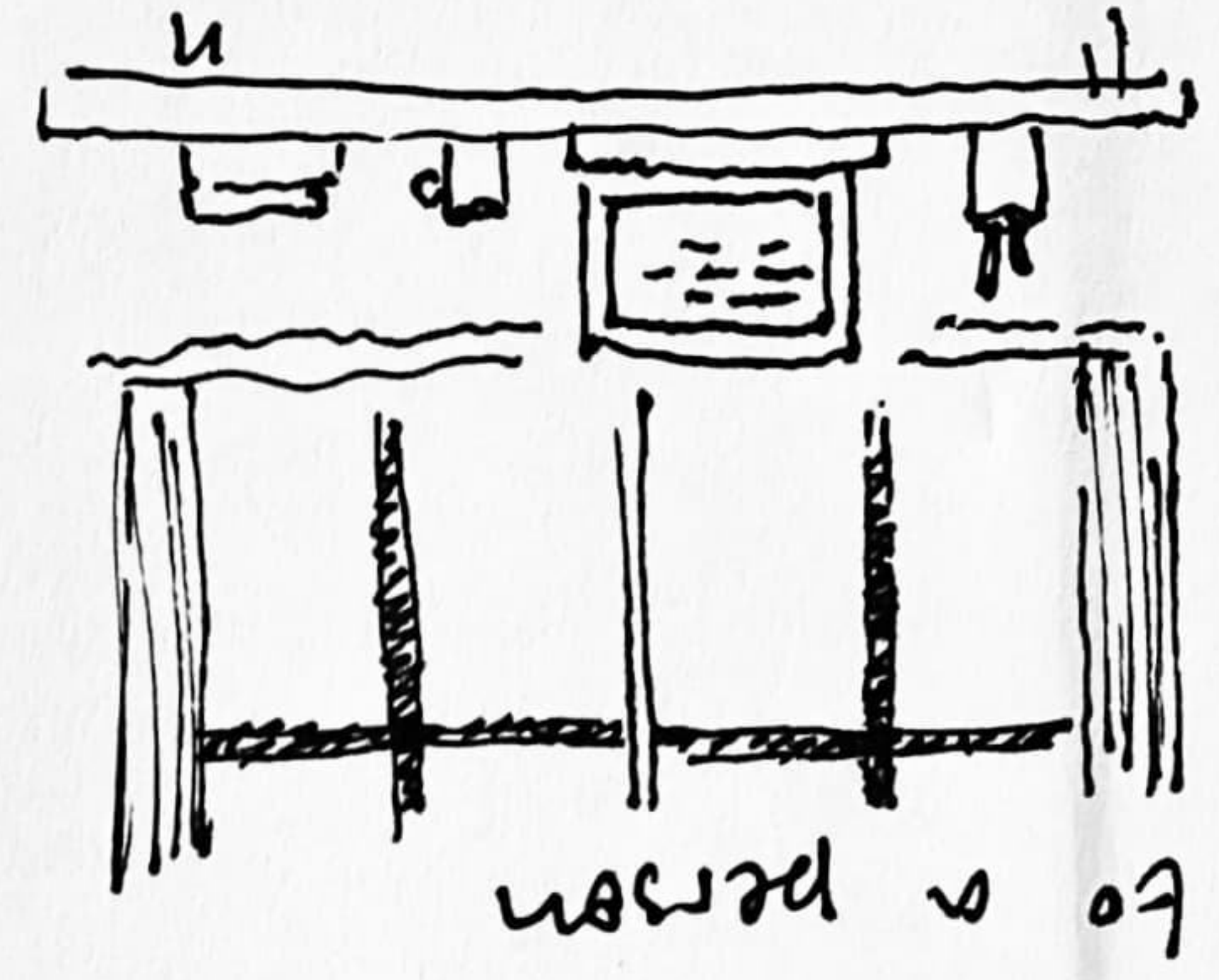


Does carved memory overwrite

separation.

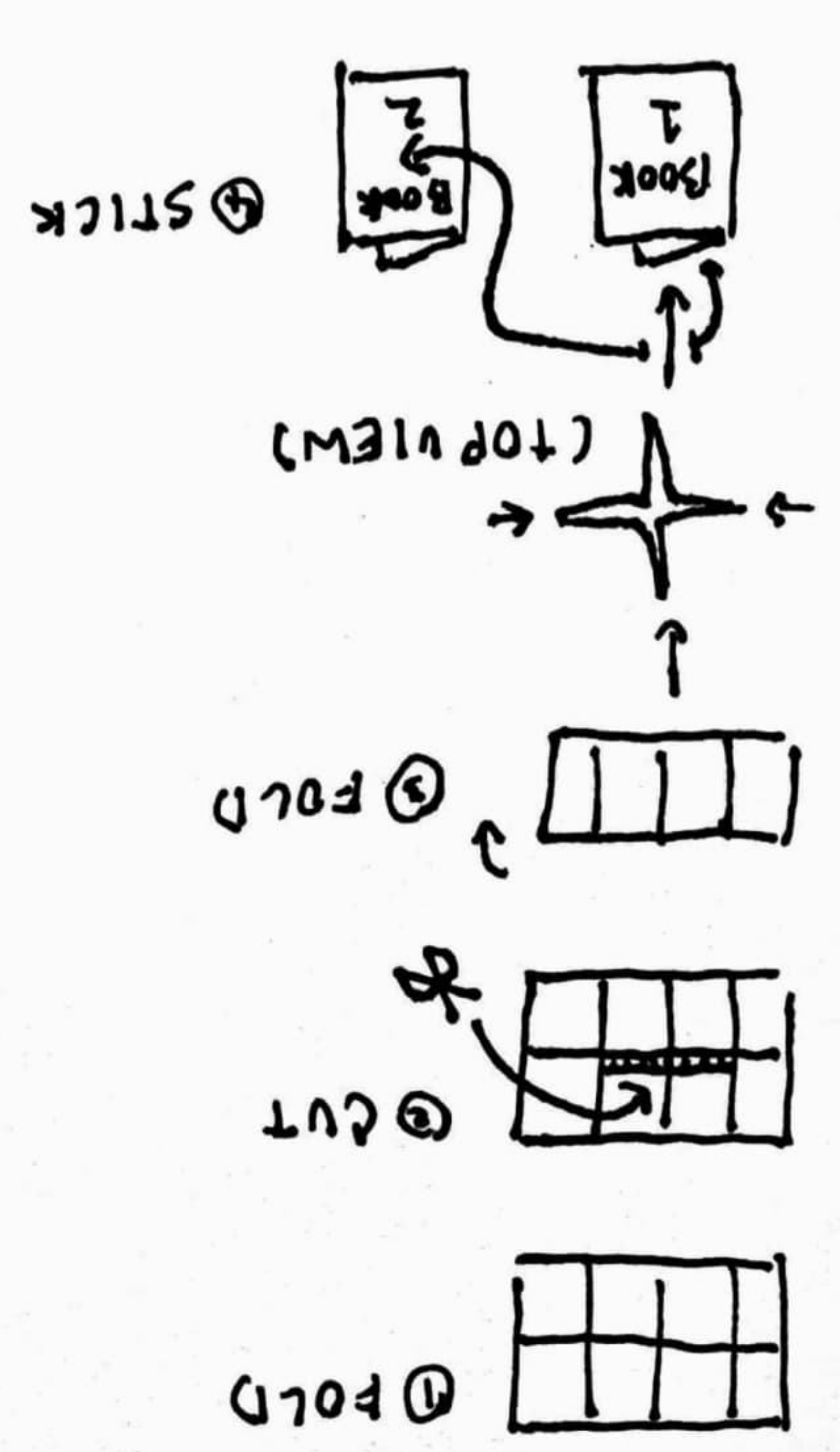


Each carries a phantom
limb that is the other.

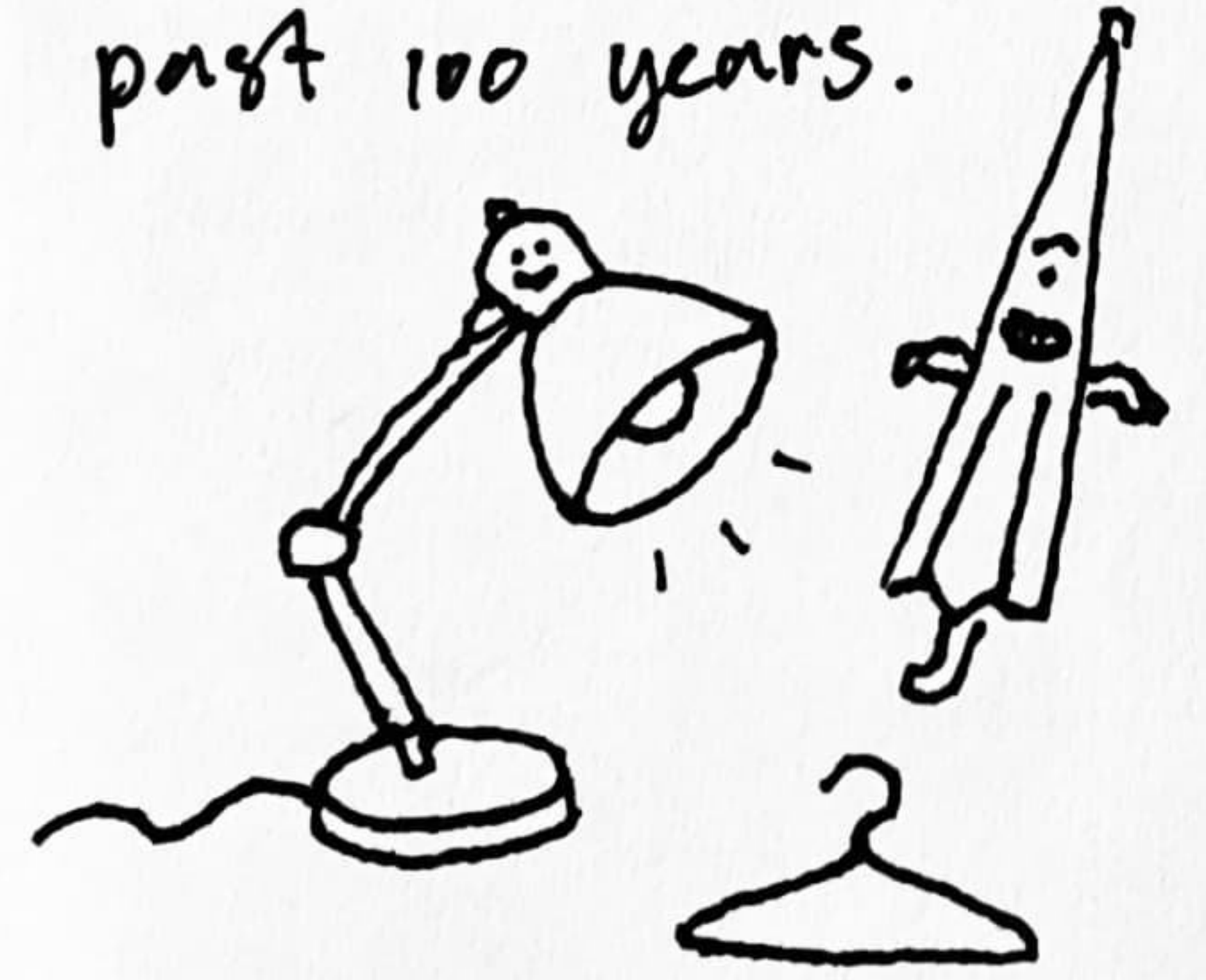

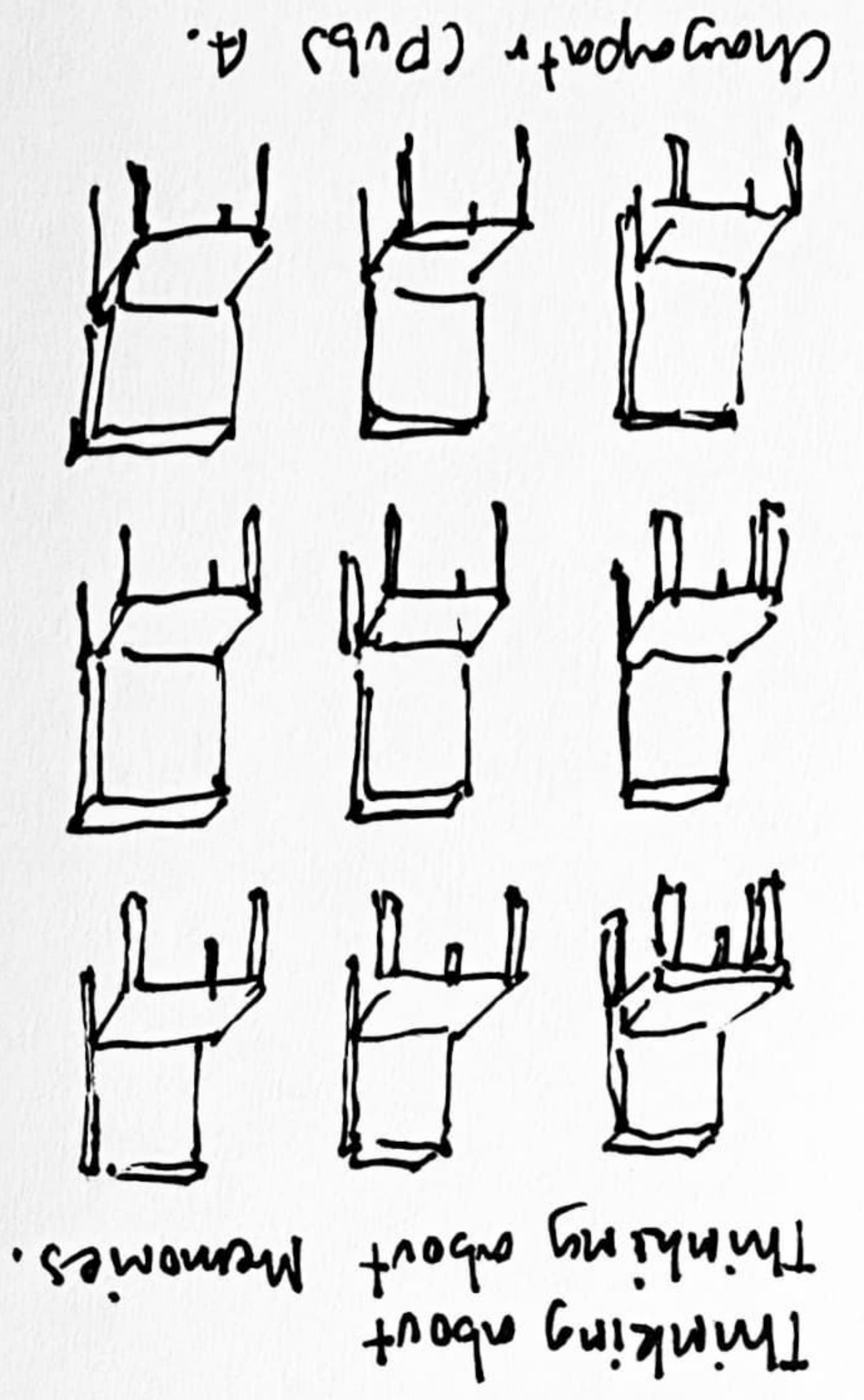
If wood were sliced into
