


To determine if something is dead, look for the absence of vital signs like breathing, heartbeat, movement, and responsiveness to stimuli, as well as signs like rigor mortis (stiffening of muscles) depending on the organism and time since death; in most cases, a medical professional is needed to officially declare death.

Key indicators of death:

- No breathing: Check for chest movement indicating respiration.
- No heartbeat: Listen for a pulse using a stethoscope or feel for a pulse in a major artery.
- Lack of movement: Observe for any voluntary muscle contractions.
- No response to stimuli: Check for reactions to pain or light.
- Pupils fixed and dilated: In animals, this is a common sign of death.
- Rigor mortis: Stiffening of muscles that occurs after death, usually starting within a few hours.


